# Jump Start Summer Camp Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

# 1. What is Jump Start Summer Camp?

Jump Start Summer Camp is a program of Hope Vision Center. We are a summer day camp/enrichment program. Through partnership with Elite Academic Academy, an accredited California public charter school, and community partners we offer academic support and various enrichment activities such as arts & crafts, sports fitness, games, and much more!

# 2. Where is the program located?

We have Summer Camps in multiple locations. Here is a list of cities where we will be hosting Summer Camps for Summer 2020:

- Hemet
- Moreno Valley
- San Bernardino

\*Note: Locations are subject to change and are available for enrollment on a first come basis.

# 3. When is the program?

For Summer 2020, our camps are five-weeks long and run from July 1 - August 5. All camps will be closed July 4th in observance of Independence Day.

# 4. What days/times are classes offered?

Classes are held Monday -Thursday from 10am - 2pm.

#### 5. Who can attend?

The program is open to K-8th grade students

\*Note: Students must be 5 years old by Sept 1, 2020 to attend.

#### 6. How much does it cost to attend?

\$500/student <u>OR</u> \$0 out-of-pocket for students who enroll in Elite Academic Academy's Year Round Track <u>AND</u> complete Elite courses.

### 7. Do I need to provide lunch for my child/ren?

A FREE lunch and snack is provided during program hours. However, students are welcome to bring their own lunch and snack to meet personal preferences and dietary restrictions.

#### 8. What type of enrichment classes are offered?

At a minimum, the following classes/activities will be offered: tutoring (math, english/language arts, science and social studies), arts & crafts, and sports fitness (i.e. Zumba, Basketball, Golf, etc.)

# 9. How many students will be in a class?

The staff-student ratio will be no more than 1:30. There will only be 30 students in a class at a time.

# 10. Will I need to purchase any items for my child/ren to participate in the program?

Hope t-shirts are optional and will be available for purchase. Additional material or excursion fees may be required for participation in special or off-site activities; you will be notified of fees as opportunities become available.

# 11. How can my child/ren Jump Start Summer Camp? You will need to:

There are two options to register for Jump Start Summer Camp: The <u>Elite Package</u> and <u>HOPE Package</u>. Both packages run for 5-weeks, are open to K-8th grade students, and offer the same activities at all our locations; but have different costs. See more details below:

#### Option 1: Elite Package

- \$0 Out-of-Pocket Cost
- MUST enroll in Elite Academic Academy's Year Round Track to use this option (You will need to complete both the HOPE registration form and Elite enrollment form)
- Student MUST complete Elite Academic Academy Courses

# Option 2: HOPE Package

- \$500/student
- Only complete HOPE registration form (Student is not enrolled in Elite Academic Academy's Year Round Track)

# To register:

- 1. Go to <a href="https://www.hopevisioncenter.org/summercamp">https://www.hopevisioncenter.org/summercamp</a> and click the "Register" button.
- 2. On the HOPE registration page, find the location you want your child to attend and your child's grade (the grade they were in for the 2019/2020 school year), then click "Register".
- 3. Complete the HOPE registration form (You need to complete a separate HOPE registration form for each child interested in attending summer camp). Make sure to select either the Elite Package <u>OR</u> HOPE Package on the registration form.
- 4. If you selected the Elite Package, also complete Elite's enrollment form and submit additional documents at https://www.eliteacademic.com/enroll-now/.
  - ★ Enter enrollment code: Hope2020 on the enrollment form.
  - ★ Elite's Enrollment Deadline: May 22, 2020 (A completed registration form and all additional documents must be received by this date)

#### **Required Documents for Elite Enrollment:**

- Enrollment Application
- Immunization Records
- Proof of Residency
- High School transcripts (for High School students)
- A copy of the student's 504 or Individual Education Plan (IEP), if applicable.
- Birth Record, Oral & Health Exam Forms (for Kinder and 1st grade students)
